Business Meeting Minutes

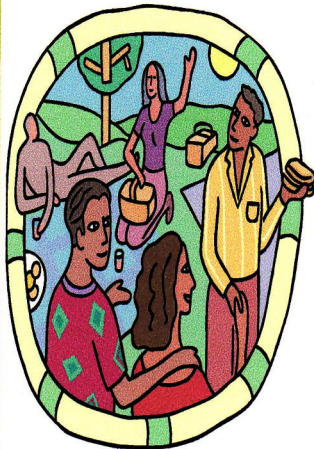
